


We are committed to establishing a Chinese brand for environmental protection and public welfare, and to growing into the most influential grant-making modern foundation!







- "Free Flying Wings" (FFW) is a comprehensive ecological conservation program that aims to safeguard migratory birds and their habitats in China.
- The program carries out conservation work through "Socialized Participation Model", which is initiated by civil organizations, invested into by enterprises, and participated in by the public.
- It builds a civil protection network and implement bird research, citizen science, and policy advocacy to promote the conservation of migratory birds and their habitats in China.









全民观鸟节 (Birding Season For All)

Birding Season for All, a citizen science birding project initiative jointly launched by SEE Foundation and Tencent Foundation. Held during the annual birds' migratory season, this program offers a variety of bird education activities aimed at increasing public awareness of birds, encouraging participation in birdwatching, and promoting the submission of bird observation data. This initiative aims to raise social awareness of bird conservation, supporting the development of the China Bird Data Center, and contribute to the advancement of bird conservation efforts in China.

Bird knowledge education platform and birdwatching record tool jointly developed and operated by the Tencent Foundation, Chinese National Geographic, and the SEE Foundation.





- Public Participation: Cooperated with partners to carry out civil protection network for migratory bird.
- Mainly address catastrophic risks by implementing basic conservation actions such as monitoring, patrols, and early warning systems, laying the foundation for further conservation.

Habitat information

• Boundary, ownership, habitat types, surrounding socio-economic conditions, etc.

Bird monitoring and patrols

• Bird monitoring records and species lists, etc., to accumulate data for bird conservation.

Threat Monitoring and Response

• Patrol tracks, threat monitoring data, etc., to identify threat locations, promptly preserve evidence, and quickly assess the situation to contact relevant authorities for early warning.

Public Participation and Education

• Education in primary and secondary schools within protected areas and surrounding communities, outreach to stakeholders, and communication with government departments to promote protection efforts.

Other Action

• Encourage partners to carry out specialized bird conservation actions based on the unique characteristics of the site, such as protection during the breeding season, bird banding, bird rescue, and other related activities.






Daliao River estuary, Yingkou, Liaoning



- ☐ The migration of waterfowls to the Daliao River Estuary is concentrated in the spring and autumn.
- □ Spring migration begins in March and continues until May each year, with northbound waterfowls gradually arriving here to rest and feed. Autumn migration is mainly concentrated from August to October.




Jiaozhou Bay, Qingdao, Shandong



- ☐ Spring migration: from March to June,

 Autumn migration: from August to October.
- □ Here, the number of waterfowls during spring is much higher than that in autumn (2-3 times).
 May be due to their circular migration route.



Program Outcomes




Promoting 9 Sites into the Protected Area System

- ◆ FFW has promoted Henan Minquan Yellow River Gudao Wetlands, Hubei Wang Lake、Tianjin Beidagang Wetlands to be included in *The List of Wetlands of International Importance (the Ramsar List).*
- ◆ Promoted the establishment of Fujian Fuqing Xinghua Bay Provincial Waterfowl Nature Reserve.
- ◆ Promoted the establishment of Protection Area, including Hubei Wuhan Fuhe Baer's Pochard Protected Area, Guangxi Fangchenggang Shanxinsha Island, Sichuan Zigong Tuojiang Wetland.
- Promoted the establishment of Hebei Luannan Nanbaozui East Provincial Wetland Park and Xinjiang Urumqi Bainiao Lake Municipal Wetland Park.


